Abstract submissions will be categorized as either clinical or physics and considered for oral presentation or poster presentation. The Abstract Review Committee will determine the best of the best through double blind review. Submissions will be scored based on the following:

1. Quality of the science cited in the abstract
2. Novelty or the level of uniqueness of the study
3. General interest in the subject of the abstract/hypothesis
4. Size of the series and the length of the follow-up
